Case Summary:

Procedural Matters:

CYP 1 has signed a declaration of having taken a 360 penalty

Facts Found:

1. 20 seconds after the start, DEN 321 was sailing on starboard and CYP 1 was sailing on port, on converging courses 2. When the boards were 2 meters apart, DEN 321 crash tacked and capsized 3. CYP 1 promptly took a 360 penalty 4. DEN 321 continued sailing after 1 minute 5. There was no damage or injury and both boards finished the race

Conclusion & Rules:

1. CYP 1 on port failed to keep clear of DEN 321 on starboard, breaking RRS 10 2. CYP 1 took the appropriate penalty for her breach 3. The score of DEN 321 in race 6 was made significantly worse through no fault of her own by a capsize because of the action of CYP 1 breaking a rule of part 2 and taking the appropriate penalty.

Decision:

DEN 321 is given redress in race 6 and will be scored points equal to the average of her scores in the other races of the day rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward) but not worse than her finishing position in race 6. This shall not change the score of the other boards. No further penalty to CYP 1

Short Decision:

DEN 321 RDG in race 6, average points from races 4 and 5. No further penalty to CYP 1
